# NEW AWARDS - HOUSTON CHAPTER

(ADDED TO EXISTING AWARDS ROSTER)

**SYNERGY AWARD-** this award is presented on behalf of the best team effort for NACE. The team can be made up of any combination of individuals or from the same company that provided an effort on behalf of NACE in 2010. This "team of awardees" is nominated by any member and voted on by the membership.

## CRITERIA

### SYNERGY AWARD

All individuals included in the award submission must be NACE members in good standing  
All individuals included in the award submission must have attended a minimum of 1 NACE meeting in 2010  
Nomination can be submitted on behalf of individuals from a variety of companies or multiple persons from the same company working on a NACE project at any level (local or national) for a specific discipline\*  
Specific examples of each nominee's role in the project must be included in the nomination. Details of project (what, when, how, value of service provided, (where- if applicable)  
Please submit not more than 100 typed words on each nominee in the team to include not more than 50 words description of the effort for the team members you feel qualify for the Synergy Award

### SOME EXAMPLES OF SPECIFIC DISCIPLINE:

multiple designers working to create total event look  
rental specialist, food and beverage team and beverage source working to create F&B presentation  
venue team or event/bridal planner(s) working to create total event package  
entertainment supplier and photo/video support for total entertainment package  
not more than 5 photos may be submitted in conjunction with this award

**Networker of the Year-** this award is for the person at NACE meetings who makes the best effort to meet guests and spread the word about NACE. This awardee can be nominated by any member and voted on by the membership

## CRITERIA:

### NETWORKER OF THE YEAR AWARD

Member in good standing of NACE Houston Chapter for minimum 1 year  
Attended multiple meetings in 2010- higher consideration for more meetings attended  
Considerations:  
Additional Organizational memberships (Houston affiliations)  
NACE committee involvement (Locally and/ or Nationally)  
Please submit not more than 100 typed words on why you feel you this person is qualified for the Networker award

**STUDENT MEMBER OF THE YEAR-** this award is for the NACE student member that makes the most contribution to NACE. (EXCLUDING the student chapter president) This awardee is nominated and voted on by the NACE Board and Erin (student faculty Advisor) and the Student Chapter president.

## CRITERIA

### STUDENT MEMBER OF THE YEAR

Candidates will have been a student member for at least 1 year, currently in good standing.  
Student must have good academic standing.  
Attendance to at least 1 NACE Houston monthly meeting is required, and multiple Student Chapter meetings  
Must have earned at least 25 NACE points during the year being recognized.
